



Checklist for interns

Before you can intern on the islands, you have to apply for a permit of internship. This is only applicable to students with a Dutch nationality. This requires certain documents and processes which we listed below.

Permit of internship

If you have the Dutch nationality and come to intern in the Dutch Caribbean, you have to apply for a “Stagevergunning”. This application proves that you are allowed to work as a paid intern.

You need the following documents for the application:

- Copy of a **valid** passport (black and white copy)
- Copy of your birth certificate (no older than **6 months**).
- Certificate of good conduct (no older than **6 months**).
- An medical insurance letter that states that you are covered for the duration of your stay in the Dutch Caribbean.
- Internship agreement/contract.
- Copy of your rental contract/lease.
- Proof of enrollment of current school year.
- Return ticket .

This application has to be handed in at the immigration office. Fees do apply. You have to make an appointment before visiting the office. Learn more: >>
